INDICATORS OF THE LABOUR FORCE (EMPLOYMENT AND UNEMPLOYMENT)

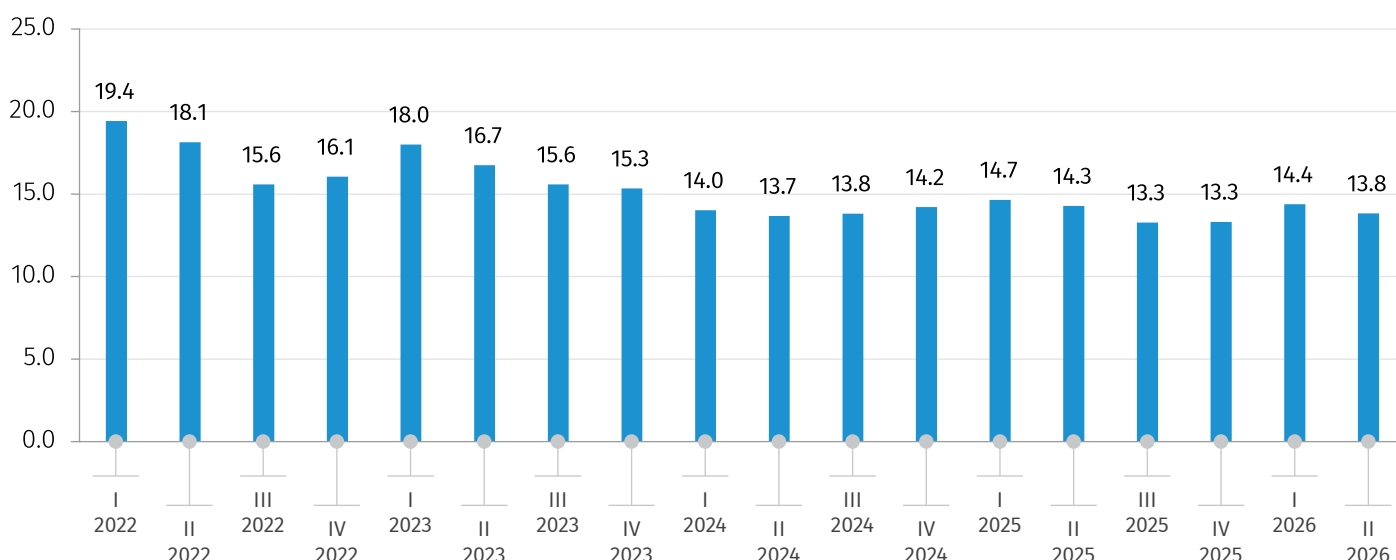
II QUARTER, 2026 YEAR

In the II quarter of 2026, the unemployment rate in Georgia decreased by 0.5 percentage points compared to the corresponding period of the previous year and equaled 13.8 percent.

The chart below presents the unemployment rate by quarters for the years 2022-2026.

CHART №1

UNEMPLOYMENT RATE IN GEORGIA (%)



In the II quarter of 2026, the labour force participation rate decreased by 0.8 percentage points compared to the corresponding period of the previous year and became 53.3 percent, while the employment rate decreased by 0.4 percentage points and amounted to 46.0 percent. The labour force participation rate decreased both in urban settlements (by 0.8 percentage points) and in rural settlements (by 0.7 percentage points) compared to the corresponding period of the previous year. The employment rate increased by 0.2 percentage points in urban settlements, while in rural settlements it decreased by 1.4 percentage points, and equaled 46.7 percent and 45.0 percent, respectively.

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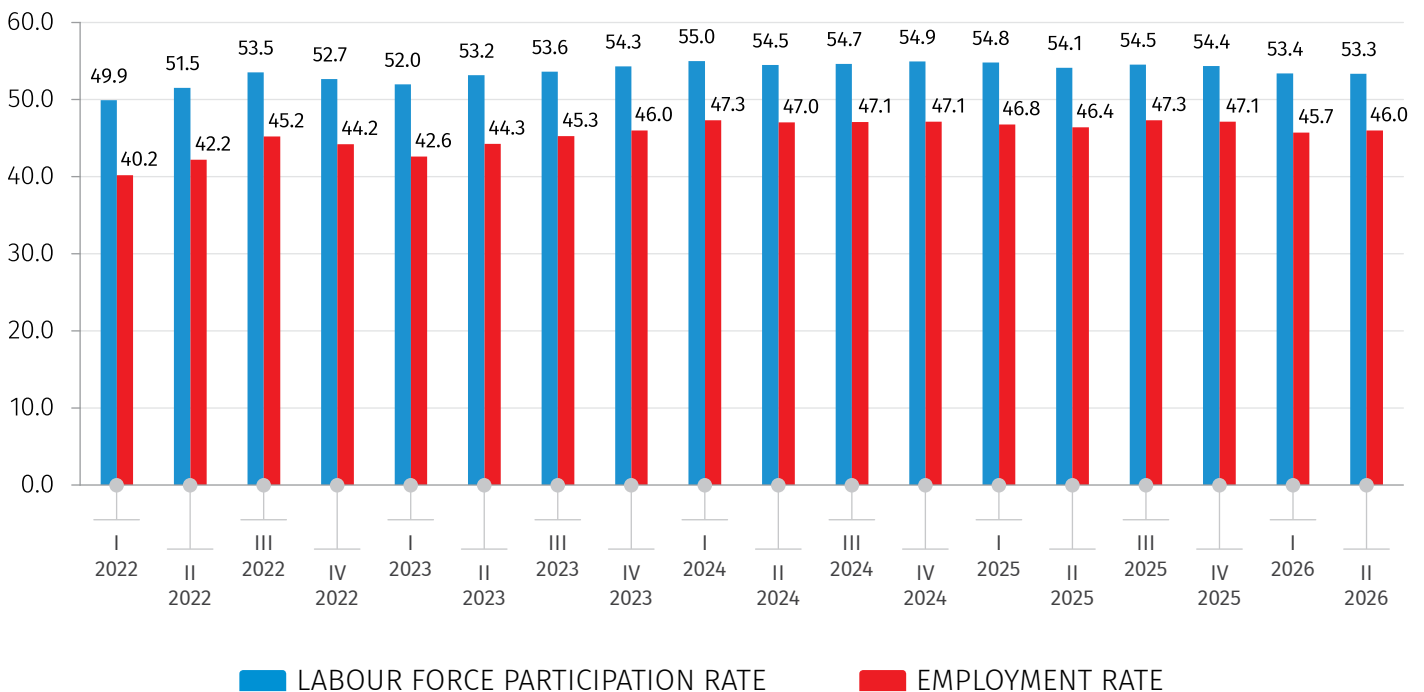

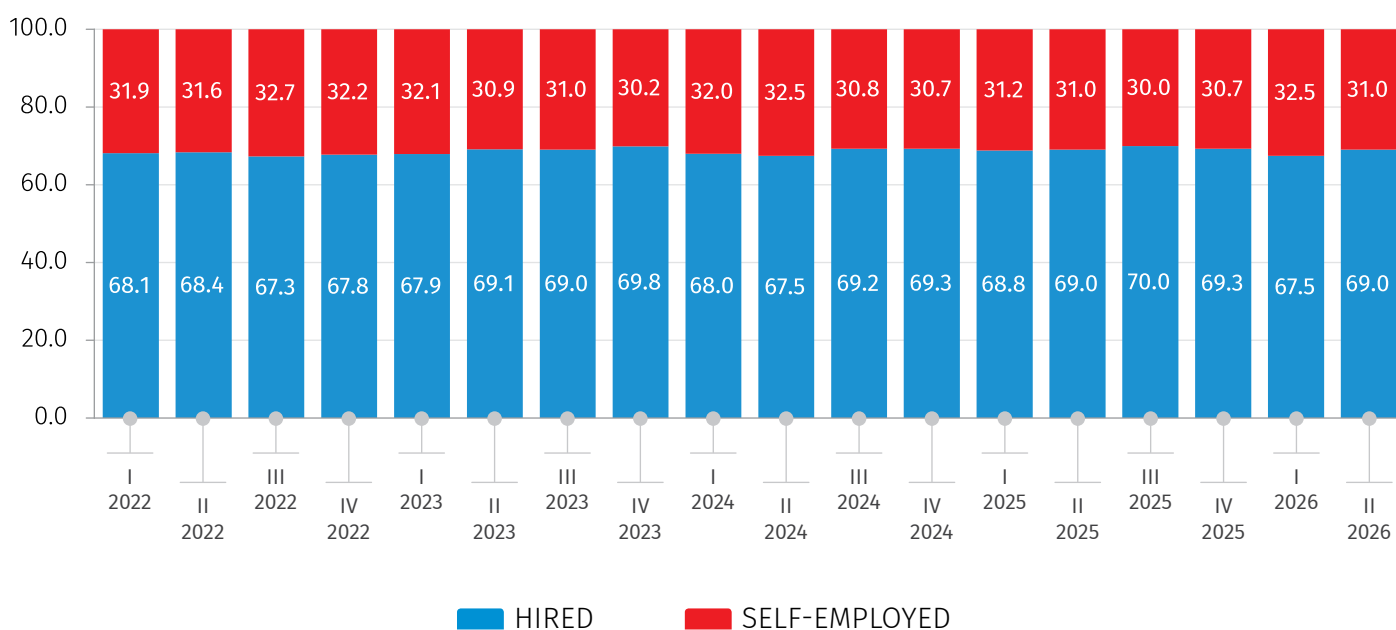
In the II quarter of 2026, compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, the share of employees in total employment remained unchanged and equaled 69.0 percent.

The chart below presents the distribution of employed by status in employment, by quarters for the years 2022-2026.

(%)



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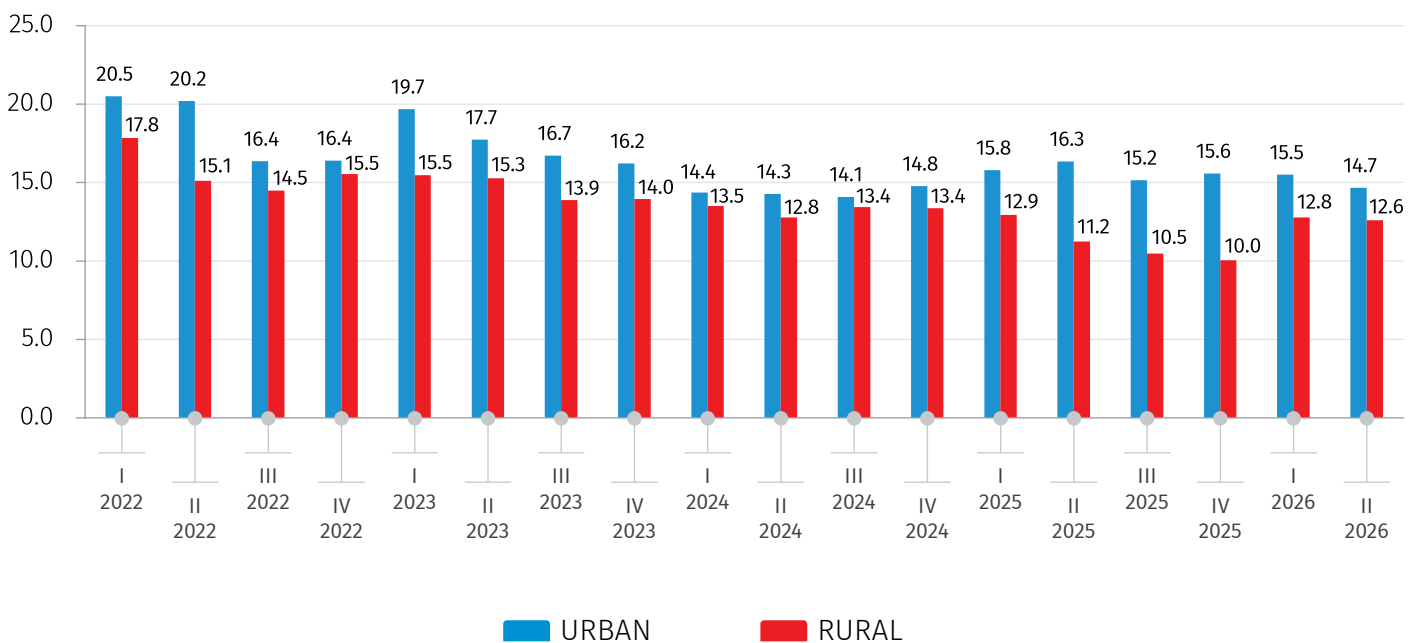
In the II quarter of 2026, compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, the unemployment rate decreased in urban settlements by 1.7 percentage points, while in rural settlements it increased by 1.3 percentage points.

The chart below presents the unemployment rate in urban and rural areas and quarters for the years 2022-2026.

(%)



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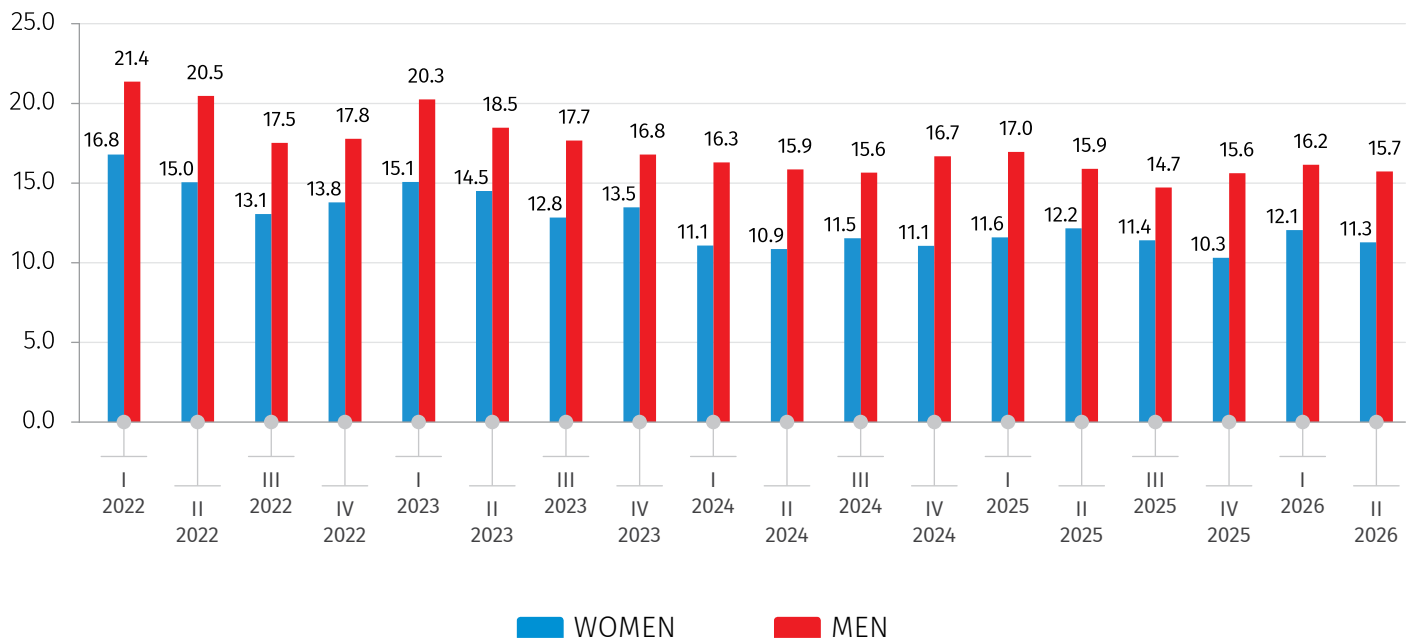
The unemployment rate is traditionally higher for men than for women. In the II quarter of 2026, compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, this rate decreased by 0.9 percentage points for women and by 0.2 percentage points for men, and amounted to 11.3 percent and 15.7 percent, respectively.

The chart below presents the unemployment rate by sex and quarters for the years 2022-2026.

(%)



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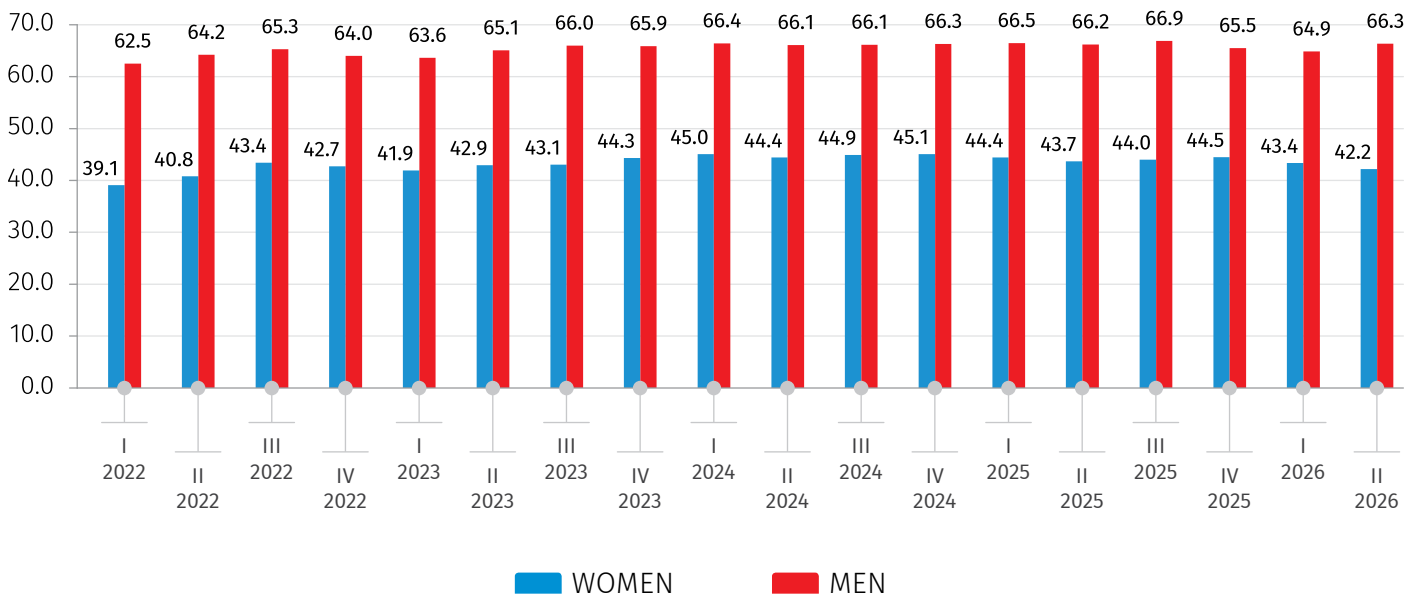
The labour force participation rate is higher for men than for women. In the II quarter of 2026, the indicator for women was 42.2 percent and for men was 66.3 percent. The labour force participation rate for women decreased by 1.5 percentage points, while for men it increased by 0.1 percentage points, compared to the corresponding period of the previous year.

(%)



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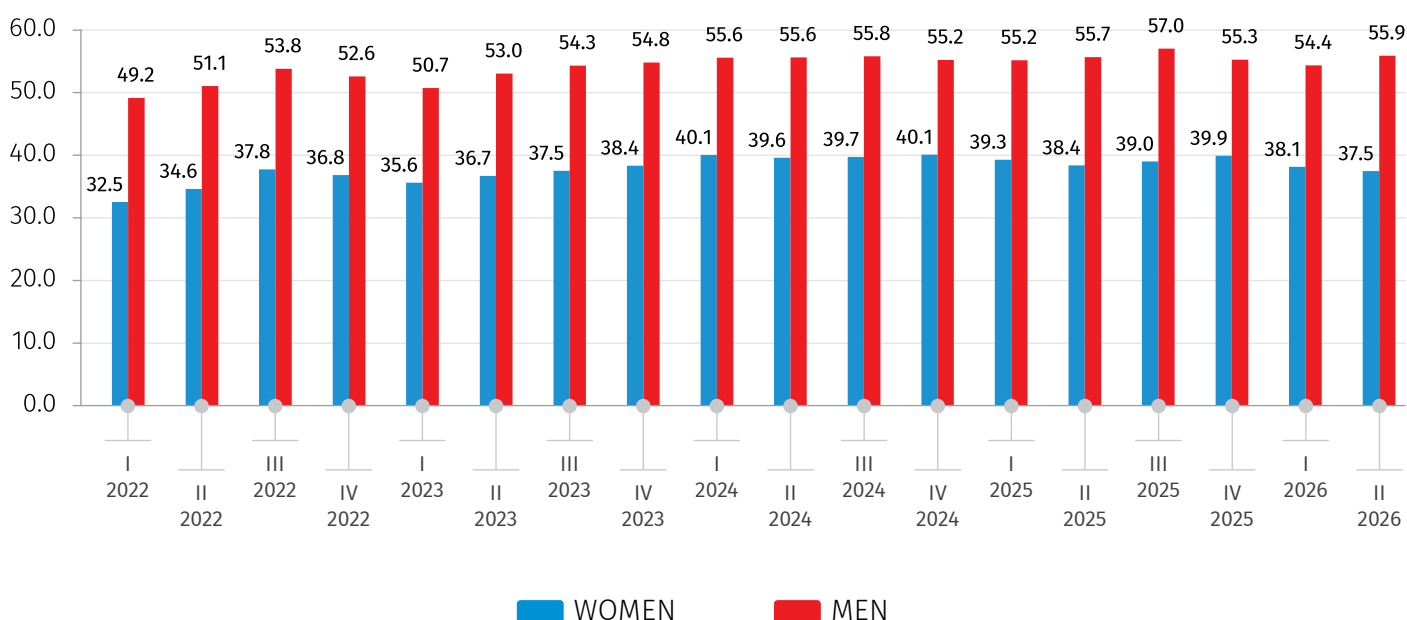
In the II quarter of 2026, compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, the employment rate for women decreased by 0.9 percentage points, while for men it increased by 0.2 percentage points.
