EXPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA JULY 2026

The Export Price Index (XPI) decreased by 0.6 percent **compared to the previous month**. In the mentioned period, the prices for mining and quarrying decreased by 4.4 percent.

Compared to July 2025 the XPI increased by 6.2 percent. The prices for mining and quarrying increased by 14.5 percent, for manufactured products by 4.9 percent, for products from water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation services by 23.4 percent. The prices for electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning decreased by 36.2 percent.

The following table shows the XPI for July 2026, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of subgroups that had a major effect on the index:

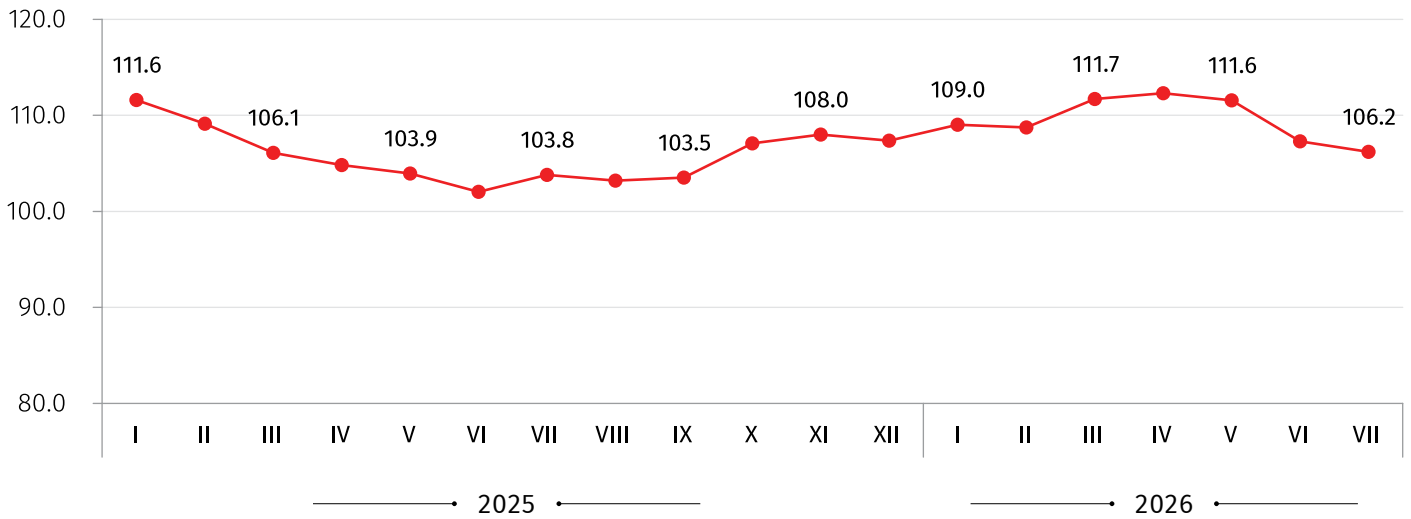
