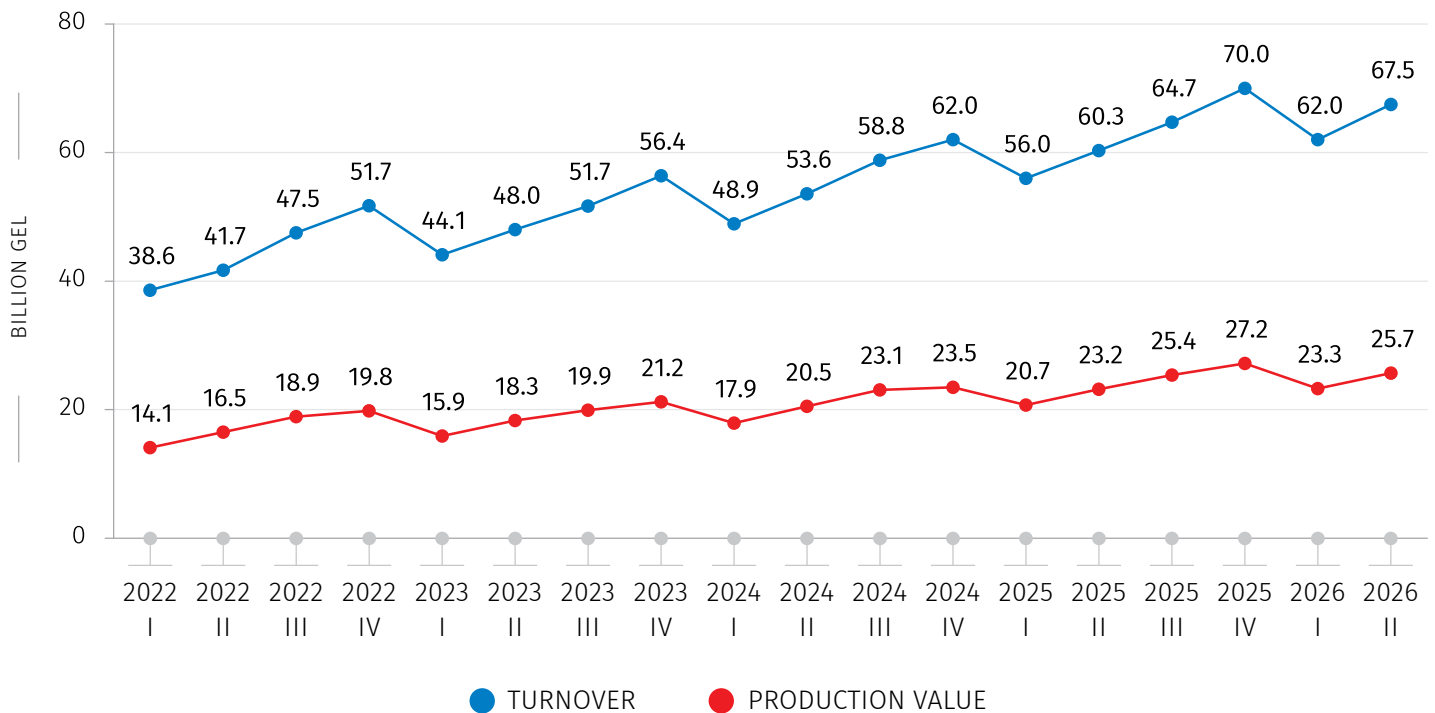

ACTIVITIES OF ENTERPRISES (II QUARTER, 2026)

In the II quarter of 2026, compared to the same quarter of the previous year, the volume of business sector turnover increased by 11.9 percent and amounted to 67.5 billion GEL.

The increase was observed in the production value of the business sector as well. In the II quarter of 2026, production value equaled 25.7 billion GEL, which is 10.7 percent more year-on-year.

VOLUME OF BUSINESS SECTOR TURNOVER AND PRODUCTION VALUE BY QUARTERS



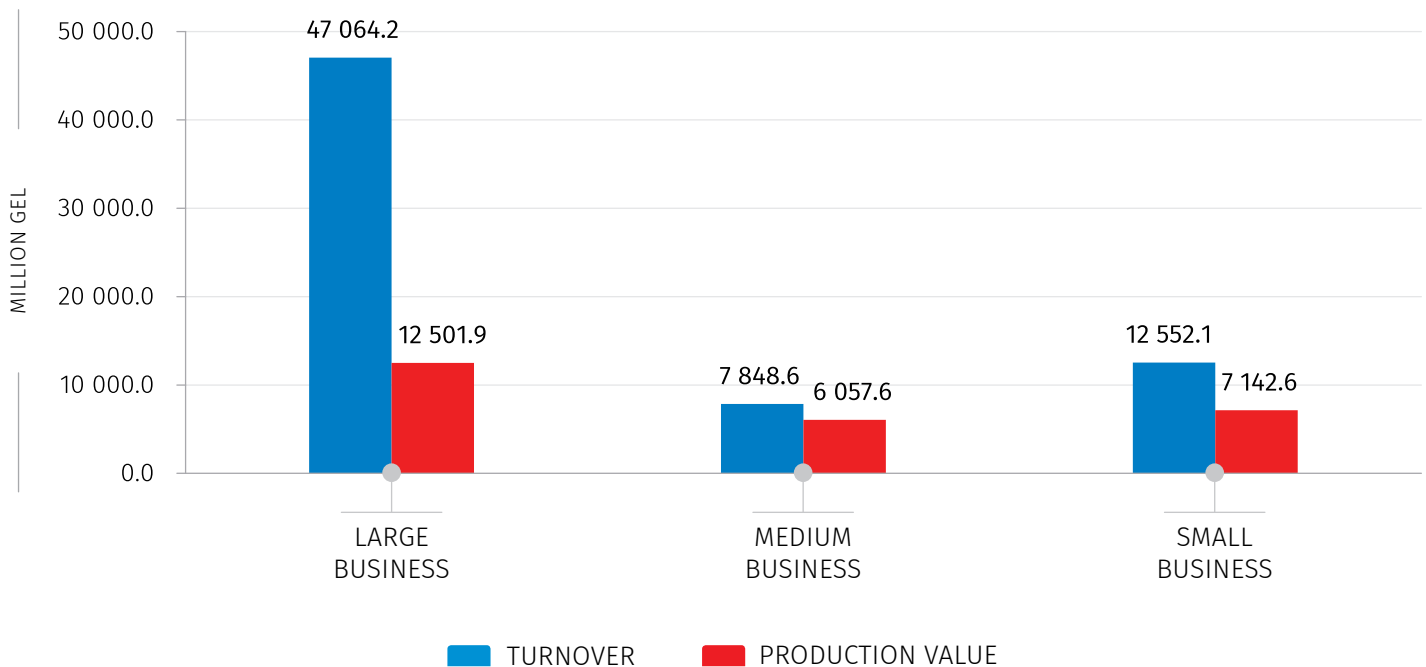

In the II quarter of 2026, large businesses generated 69.8 percent of total turnover, while medium size businesses generated 11.6 percent, and 18.6 percent was generated by small businesses.

A distribution was different in case of total production value: 48.6 percent — large businesses, 23.6 percent — medium, and 27.8 percent — small businesses.

BUSINESS SECTOR TURNOVER AND PRODUCTION VALUE BY SIZE OF ENTERPRISES, II QUARTER, 2026



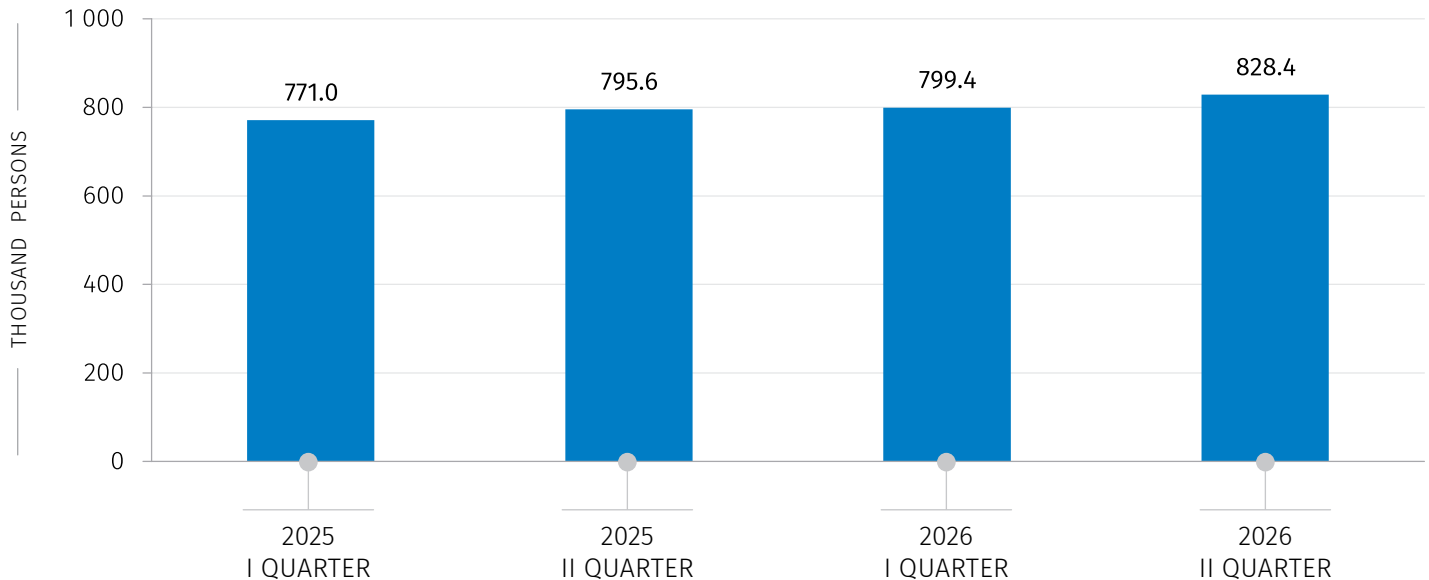
In the II quarter of 2026, total purchases of goods and services carried out by enterprises equaled 32.5 billion GEL (year-on-year 4.9 percent more), while the purchase of goods and services for resale amounted to 19.4 billion GEL (year-on-year 9.3 percent more).

In the II quarter of 2026, the average number of persons employed in business sector equaled 828.4 thousand, which is year-on-year 4.1 percent more. Out of the total number of persons employed, 43.8 percent were female and 56.2 percent were male.

Large businesses employed 42.6 percent of total number of persons, while 19.7 percent were employed by medium, and 37.7 percent — by small businesses.

The total number of employees amounted to 768.6 thousand (year-on-year 3.1 percent more) and the total personnel costs of enterprises equaled 5 827.3 million GEL (year-on-year 10.3 percent more).

In the II quarter of 2026, average monthly remuneration of employees equaled 2 471.5 GEL (153.8 GEL increase year-on-year), while remuneration specifically for women employees was 1 944.9 GEL (161.4 GEL increase year-on-year). Average monthly remuneration by size of enterprises was as follows:

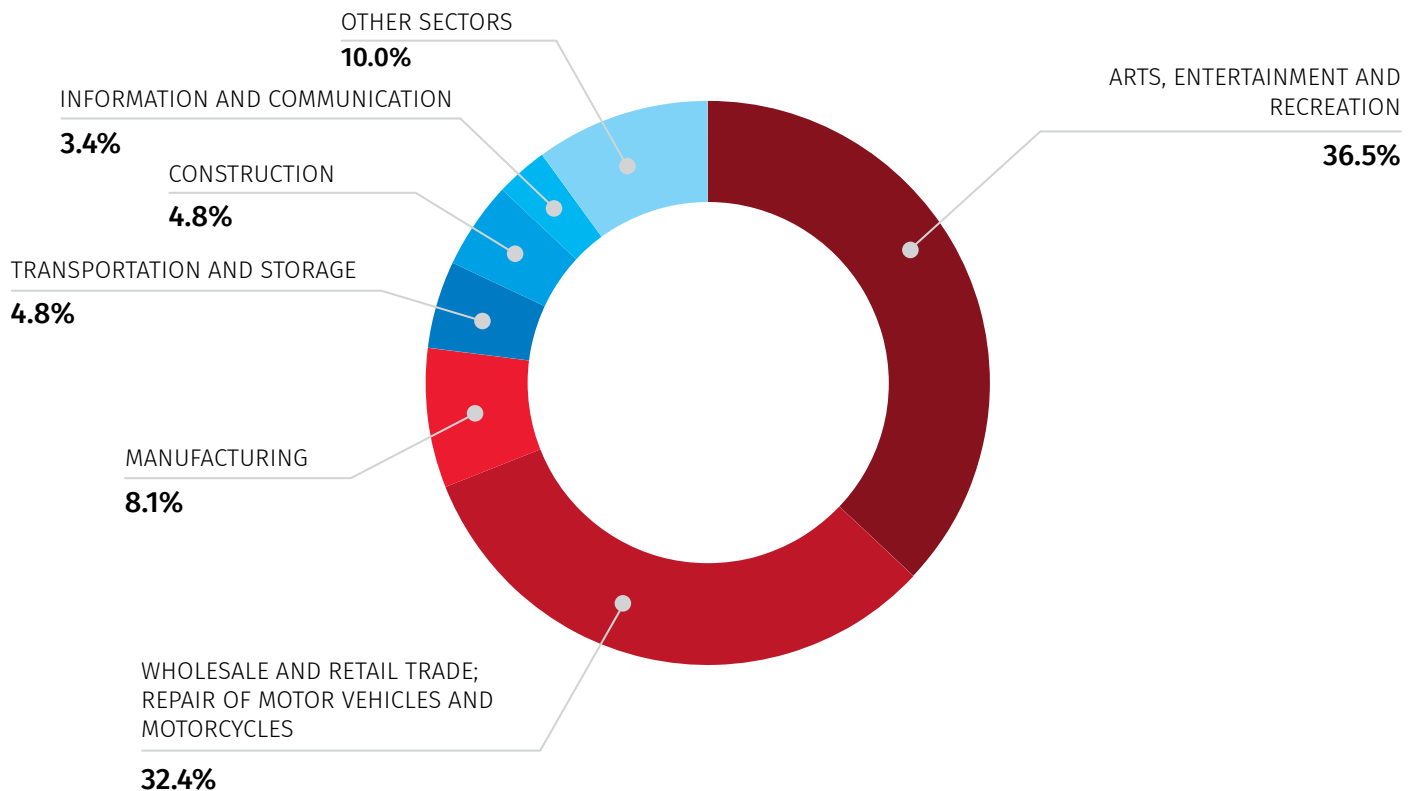
- Large business — 2 622.8 GEL;
- Medium size business — 2 918.9 GEL;
- Small business — 1 972.3 GEL.

In the II quarter of 2026, the arts, entertainment and recreation had the highest share (36.5 percent) in the total turnover in business sector, followed by trade sector (including repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles) with 32.4 percent share, manufacturing – with 8.1 percent, transportation and storage – with 4.8 percent, construction – with 4.8 percent, information and communication – with 3.4 percent, and other sectors – with 10.0 percent share.

TURNOVER IN BUSINESS SECTOR, II QUARTER, 2026

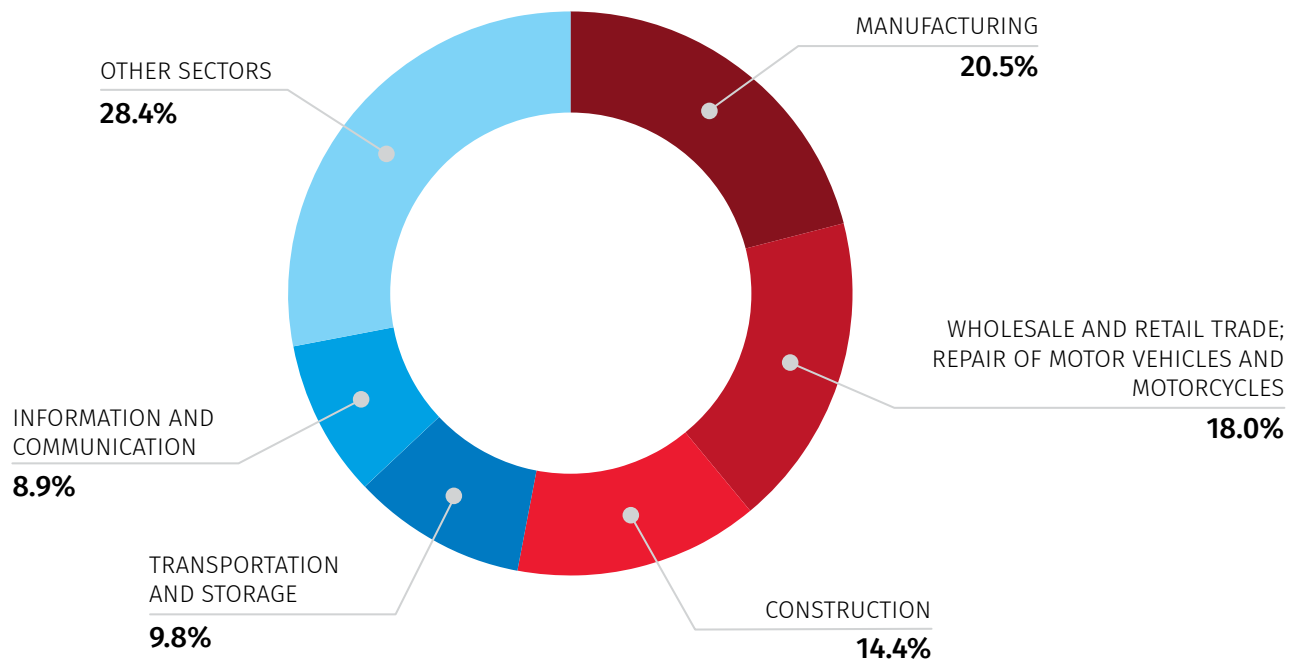

In the II quarter of 2026, manufacturing (20.5 percent), trade (18.0 percent), construction (14.4 percent), transportation and storage (9.8 percent) and information and communication (8.9 percent) held the top five places in business sector by production value. The rest of the sectors had 28.4 percent share combined.

PRODUCTION VALUE IN BUSINESS SECTOR, II QUARTER, 2026

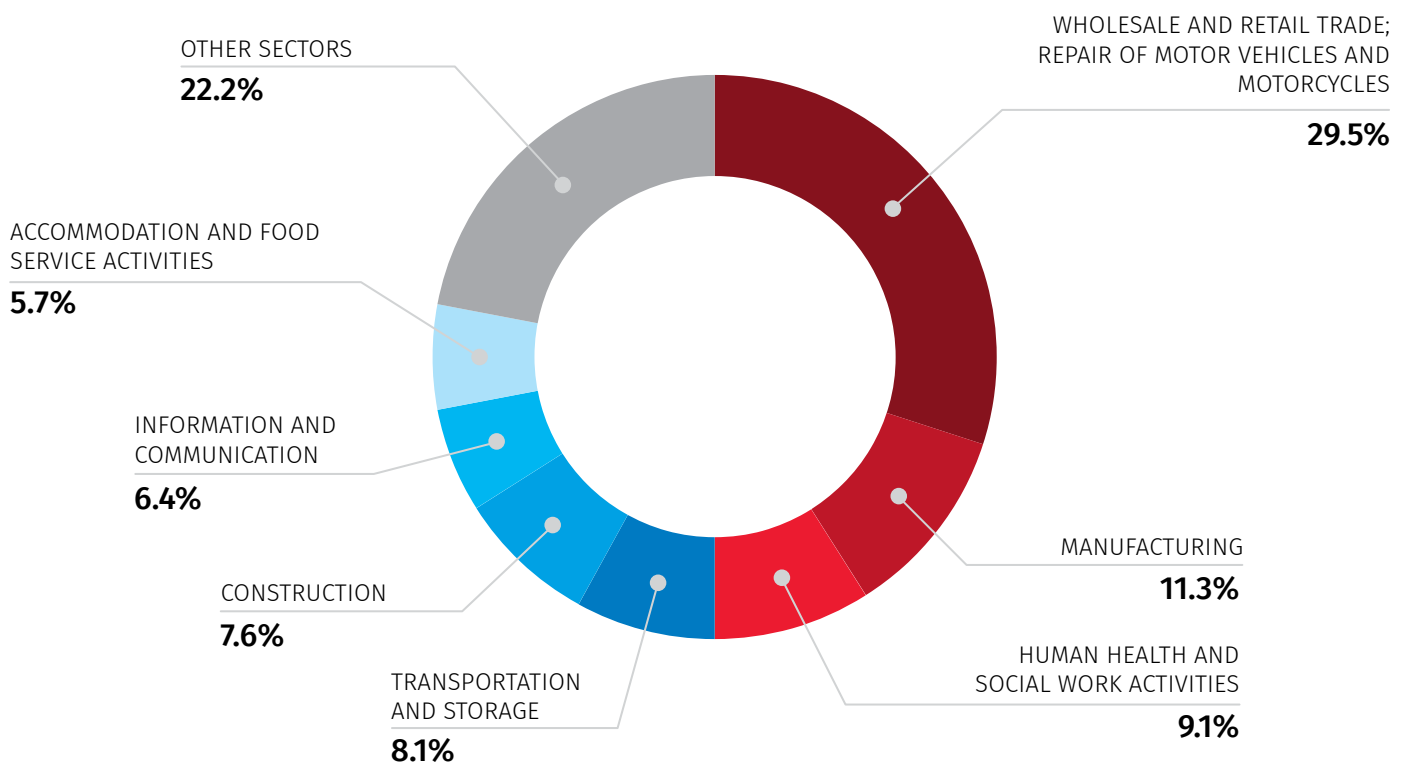

In the II quarter of 2026, trade (wholesale and retail trade; repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles), manufacturing, and human health and social work activities led business sector by number of employed persons with 29.5 percent, 11.3 percent, and 9.1 percent shares, respectively. Enterprises engaged in transportation and storage (8.1 percent), construction activities (7.6 percent), information and communication (6.4 percent), and accommodation and food service activities (5.7 percent) also had a significant share though.

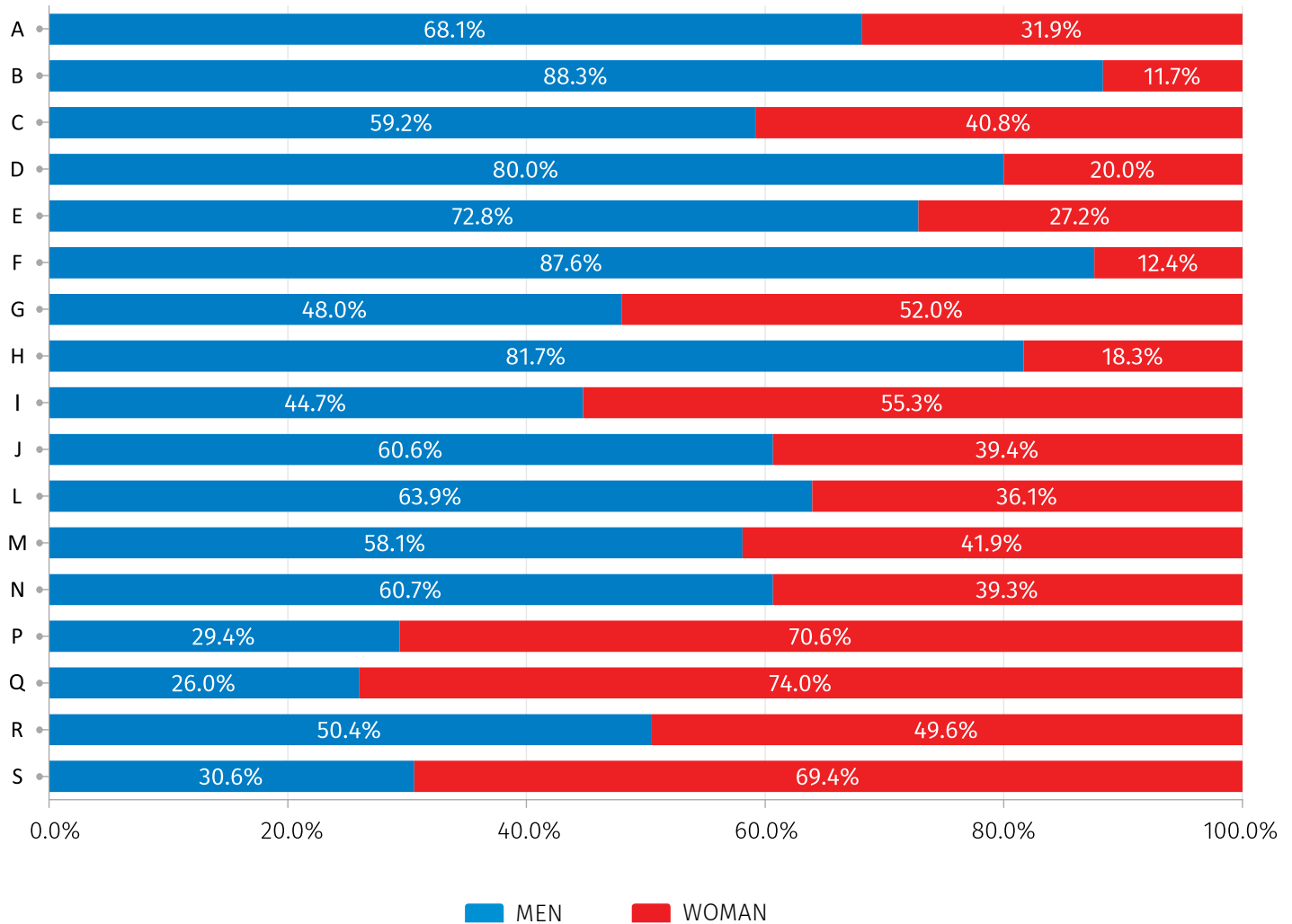
**NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES IN BUSINESS SECTOR,

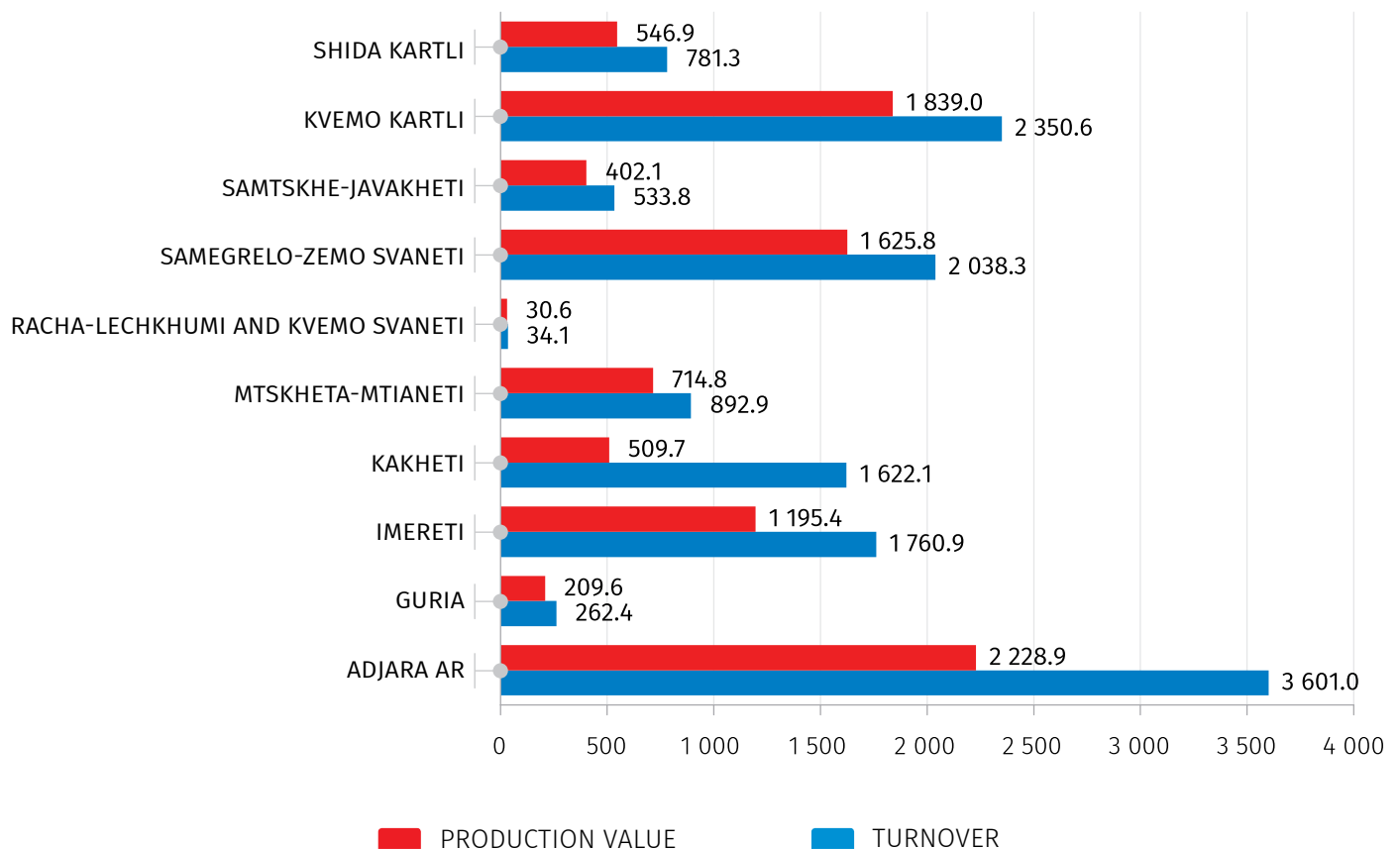

The chart below shows turnover and production value by region, except Tbilisi (in mln. GEL).



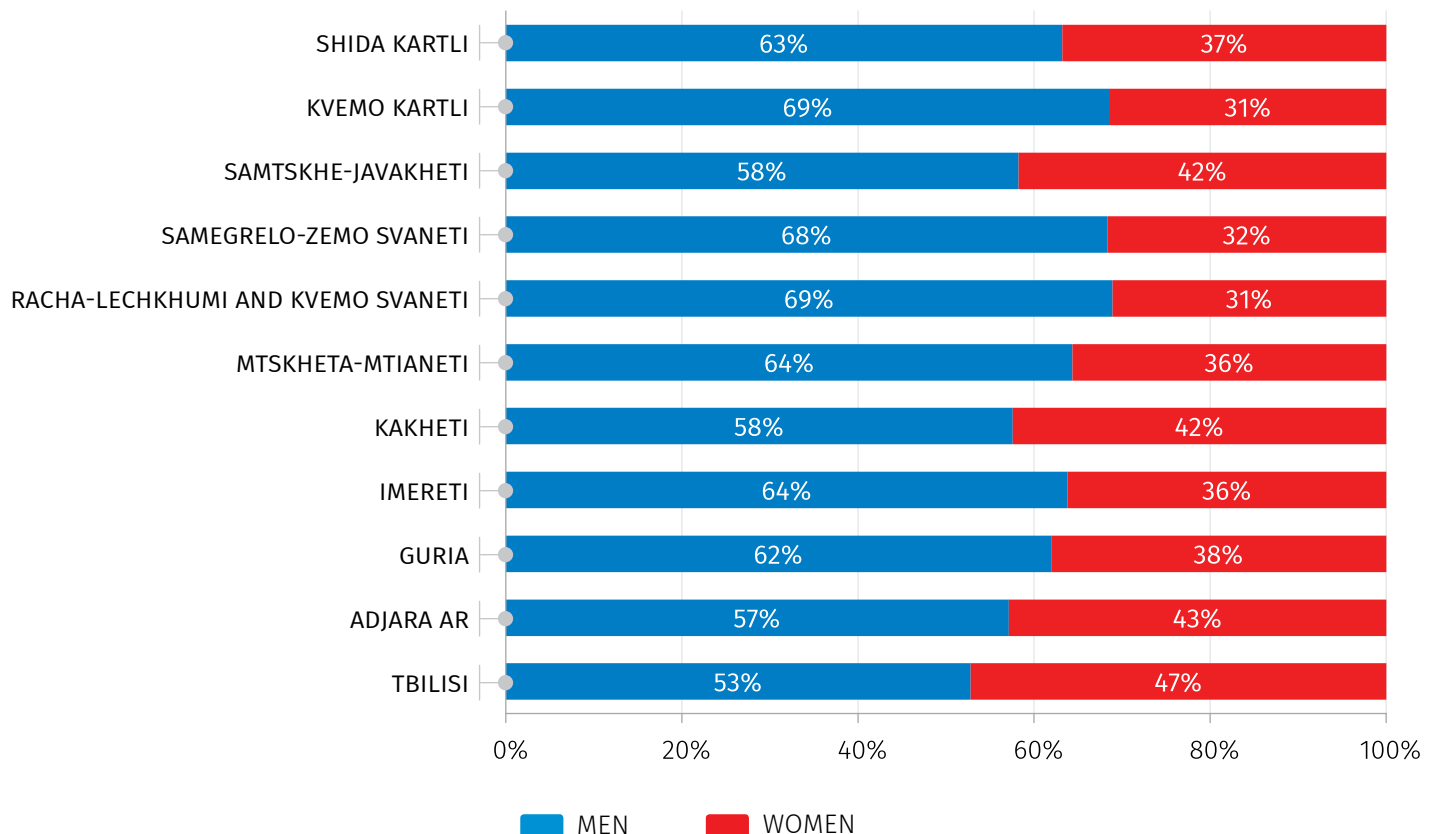
