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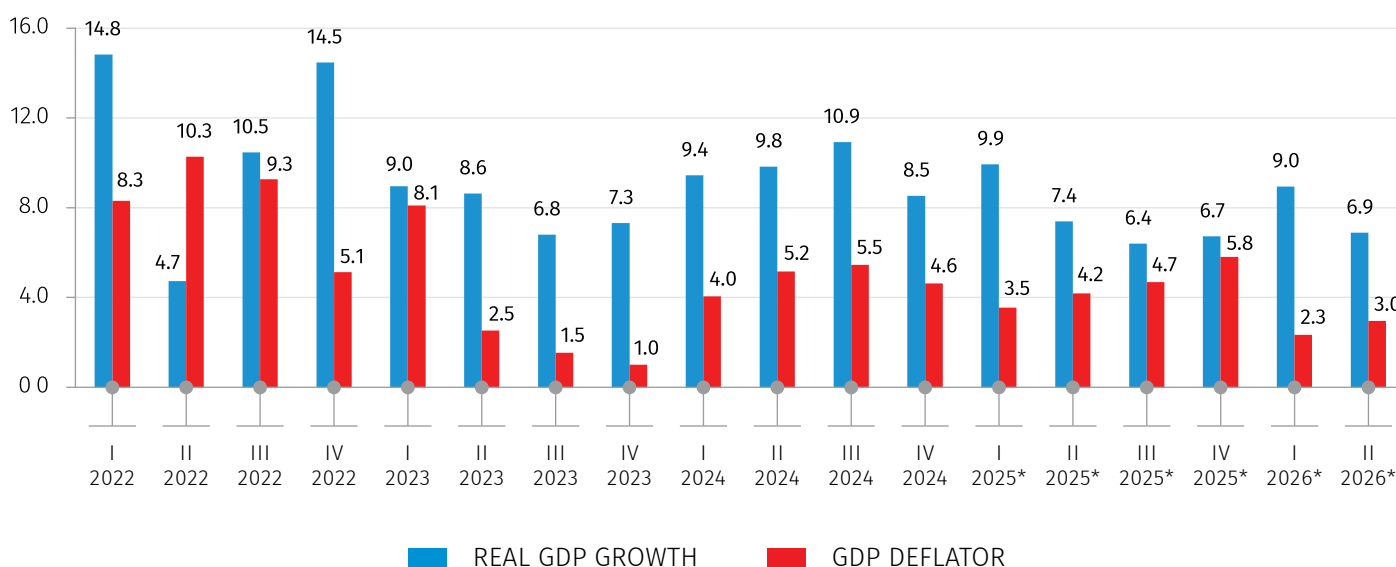
In Q2 2026 the nominal Gross Domestic Product (GDP) amounted to GEL 28 147.0 million. The real GDP increased by 6.9 percent YoY, while the GDP deflator percentage change equaled to 3.0 percent.

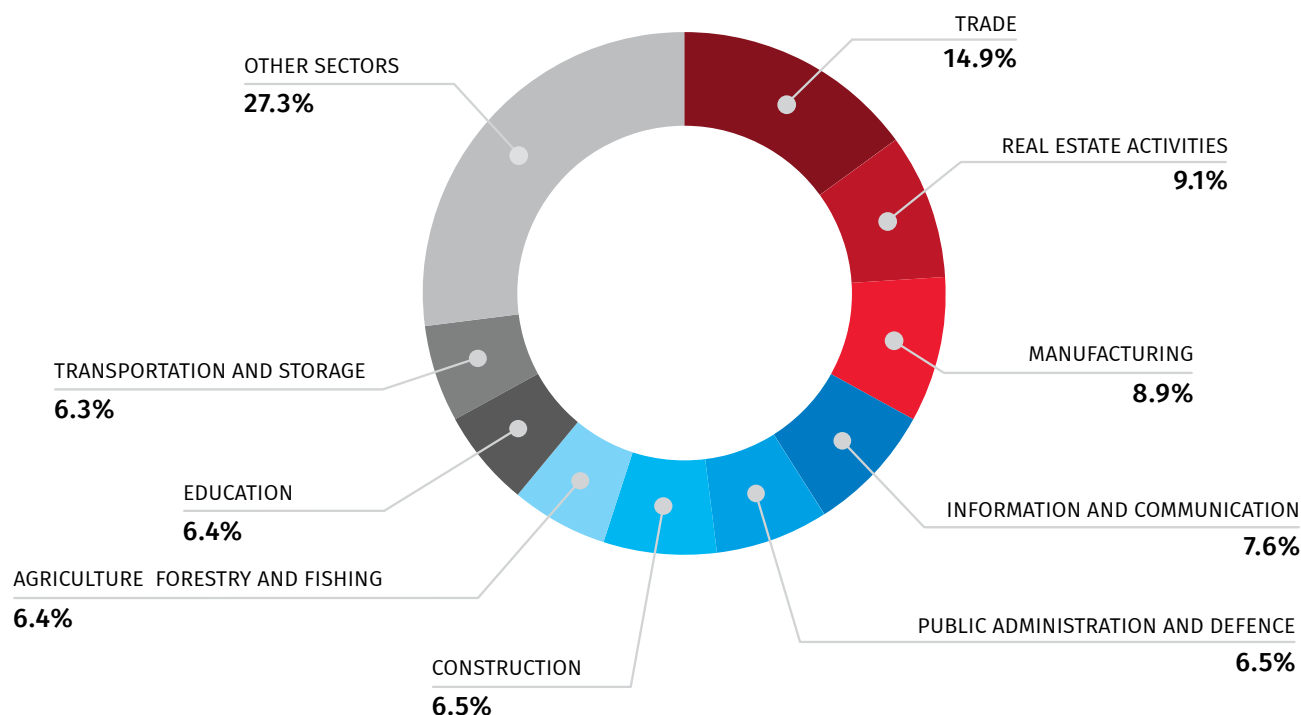

Significant contributions to the real GDP growth in Q2 2026 are related to increase of value-added of the following activities: Information and communication (16.6 percent), Wholesale and retail trade; repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles (8.0 percent), Transportation and storage (19.8 percent), Arts, entertainment and recreation (17.4 percent), Manufacturing (7.3 percent), Human health and recreation (15.0 percent).

The largest negative contributors to growth in Q2 2026 were Construction (-4.8 percent) and Agriculture, forestry and fishing (-3.5 percent).

The largest share in GDP by activity is held by Wholesale and retail trade; repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles (14.9 percent) and by Real estate activities (9.1 percent), followed by Manufacturing (8.9 percent), Information and communication (7.6 percent), Public administration and defence; compulsory social security (6.5 percent), Construction (6.5 percent), Agriculture forestry and fishing (6.4 percent), Education (6.4 percent), Transportation and storage (6.3 percent).

Note: Revised data will be published by November 13, 2026.

INFORMATION NOTE

Calculation of the quarterly Gross Domestic Product is based on a monthly and quarterly data. The data of annual surveys usually differ from the quarterly data. Therefore, arises necessity of adjusting the quarterly GDP taking into account annual survey results.

After receiving the annual survey results for the previous year, four quarters of the previous year are adjusted along with the first and the second quarters of the current year. Final revision of 2025 quarters data will be conducted in November 2026, after receiving the data of annual surveys for 2025 year.

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
