EXPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA AUGUST 2026

The Export Price Index (XPI) increased by 0.3 percent **compared to the previous month**. In the mentioned period, the prices for mining and quarrying increased by 6.8 percent.

Compared to August 2025 the XPI increased by 7.1 percent. The prices for mining and quarrying increased by 22.5 percent, for manufactured products by 4.8 percent, for products from water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation services by 29.1 percent. The prices for electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning decreased by 36.3 percent.

The following table shows the XPI for August 2026, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of subgroups that had a major effect on the index:

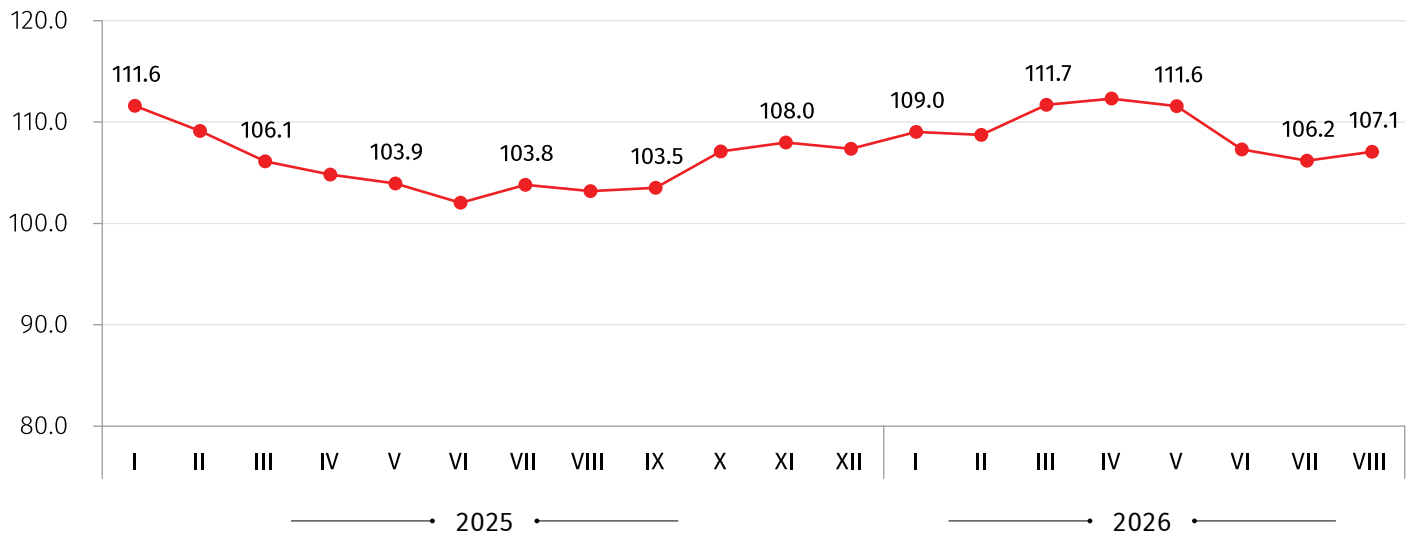
